THE ART OF BECOMING AGELESS

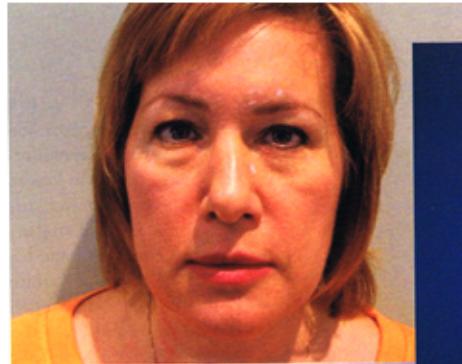
Once you have made the decision to embark on the journey of plastic surgery, the choice of which surgeon you will select becomes unquestioningly the most important decision you will make.

The contemporary approach to surgical rejuvenation of the face is now an attempt to restore facial volume lost due to the aging process and to develop facial contouring to emulate youthful facial features. Plastic surgeons capitalize on the possibilities of repositioning and contouring facial areas such as the lips, cheeks, jowls and chin. This can give the patient time before having to consider a surgical procedure. Dr. Marc DuPéré, a board certified plastic surgeon who has an office in Richmond Hill at the Age-Less Clinic and in downtown Toronto, at VISAGE Clinic is a specialist in facial volume and contour restoration. Dr. DuPéré uses injectable dermal

fillers to help restore facial volume associated with a youthful appearance and they are an important component in his practice. Dr. DuPéré has participated in many FACE meetings in North America and has the prestigious position as one of the few physician trainers for Medicis Aesthetics in Canada. Dr. DuPéré has developed many of the newest techniques relating to facial volume restoration. He is considered one the North America's leading experts, in non-surgical 3-D facial rejuvenation using injectable dermal fillers.

Injectable dermal fillers do not require incisions, cuts or stitches and can be used on most patients. However, it involves careful and meticulous application into the facial areas which will benefit from volume restoration. This treatment is further individualized to match each patient's unique aesthetic needs.

In helping a patient to make decisions about their plastic surgery goals, Dr. DuPéré examines and assesses each patient's facial features and how each component affects the patient's overall appearance. Using "Gold Standard" lasers - such as the Erbium Sciton microlaserpeel and resurfacing, BBL, Fraxel and Blue light - and Obagi medical skin care, Dr. DuPéré improves the texture and tone of

skin, remove brown spots and red spots, clears acne, smoothes acne scars and removes hair. A beautiful face begins with beautiful skin.

Dr. DuPéré is one of the few surgeons in Canada to have completed international training and been mentored by the elite plastic surgeons in Europe, New York and California. Dr. DuPéré brings this training and European refinement to his approach to the practice of plastic surgery.
