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Post Pregnancy Surgery

"Most of our female patients feel that their femininity has been stolen. I wouldn't say there is anger there, but there is a lot of disappointment."

"There is not a lot you can do," admits DuPéré, who says that age, genetics and skin's elasticity are the major deciding factors. "And keep in mind that the greater the change in weight, the greater the effect will be," he adds, recommending exercise before and during pregnancy.

There is nothing wrong with going through pregnancy again, and surgery won't prevent you from becoming pregnant, but the physiology, the changes, that happen with pregnancy will happen again.
